the **Building of Caja**

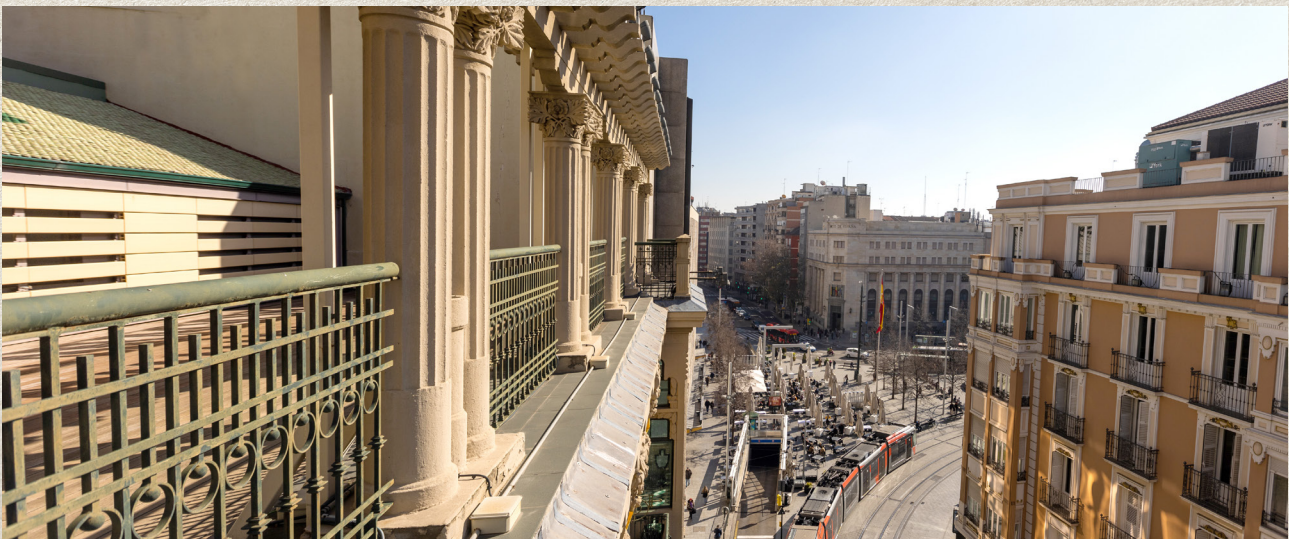
Rural de Aragón are located on
the fourth floor. Both can be hired
for various occasions, ranging from
holding events to being used as extra
space for larger gatherings. Inside, it
is decorated with plaster mouldings
that, in turn, can be found across
all the halls of this unique building.
These were installed during the

restoration works led and
supervised by José María
Valero, the architect from
Zaragoza. The exterior
part of the terrace offers a
panoramic view of Spain Square
(Plaza España) and El Coso street,
both of which have been deemed
focal points of social, economic
and cultural life in Zaragoza for
centuries. Holding events at the
top of this building provides a high





and often unexpected
perspective. From the
terrace, one can observe
plant and vegetation
elements carved in stone

that make up the floral design
of the building. On the fourth floor,
you can find samples of ivy and
ranunculus, which, in turn, are two
of twelve plant species that make up
the vertical garden of the façade: a
carefully handpicked selection.
